Over 2,500 families have benefited from our commitment to higher education. In 2015, 106 union members and union family members have been awarded \$150,000 in scholarships, ranging from \$500 to \$4,000. The 2016 Scholarship deadline is fast approaching (January 31, 2016), so apply today!

Disaster Relief Grants: With the recent number of natural disasters around the country as a result of erratic weather, Union Plus makes available the Disaster Relief Grant to Union members who are facing financial hardship due to a natural disaster. Notably, this money does not need to be repaid. If you or a Union brother or sister has suffered financial hardship as a result of certified natural disasters, check out the eligibility requirements.
