Tell Senate Leader Schumer - Confirm FLRA Nominees Now!

Over a year into the Biden Administration, a Trump-appointed majority on the Federal Labor Relations Authority (FLRA) is wreaking havoc on our federal workforce and continuing the last administration's attacks on federal workers' union rights.

Meanwhile, President Biden's nominations for the FLRA are sitting in the Senate waiting to be confirmed.

Senate Majority Leader Schumer can prioritize restoring fairness to the FLRA and stop this anti-union FLRA majority from carrying on the last administration's attack on federal workers' collective bargaining rights.
