I invite you to serve on the Federal Advisory Council on Occupational Safety and Health (FACOSH) as a labor representative for three years commencing from the date of this letter through December 31, 2025.

FACOSH is authorized by 5 U.S.C. 7902 and established pursuant to Executive Order 11612 to advise the Secretary of Labor on matters related to occupational safety and health of federal workers, including techniques to develop and maintain effective occupational safety and health programs and ways to reduce and minimize the number and severity of injuries and illnesses in the federal workforce. FACOSH consists of 16 members appointed by the Secretary of Labor and is chaired by the Assistant Secretary of Labor for Occupational Safety and Health. The membership is balanced with equal representation of federal agency management and labor organizations representing federal employees.

FACOSH generally meets at least two times a year. Members usually serve three-year terms. The Department of Labor (DOL) will pay authorized travel-related expenses for you to attend FACOSH meetings, but you will not be otherwise compensated for serving on this committee.

Your participation will be valuable in helping DOL improve workplace safety and health for federal workers.
